RULES OF THE GAME

- 1. DRESS CODE: Standard golf attire please.
- 2. Winter rules will apply:
 - You may move your ball up to 6 inches, but no closer to the hole with the ball being hand-placed in position.
 - The ball may not be moved from out of bounds or any hazard or from any different type of file.
 - The ball cannot be moved out of the rough, or first cut, or to any better condition.
 - On the green, the ball that is chosen to be putted, must be marked and each ball placed on the exact position, no six inch rule.
- 3. For threesomes, each team must set a consistent rotation so that one player from the group plays two balls for each hole (i.e. every third hole, each player plays two balls for the hole).
- 4. Play will be from tee 5 for men and tee 3 for women. Play will be "READY GOLF".
- 5. The format for the tournament is a scramble, meaning each player tees off, the best shot is selected, all players move their ball to that location and all players hit again. Again, the best shot is selected and all players move their ball to the best shot location and continue playing until putting out.
- 6. All putts must be putted out. There are no "gimmies".
- 7. If there are any ties, money in the auction and prize money from NECA will be pooled and evenly divided among the winners.

CALCUTTA RULES

- The minimum bid for the Calcutta shall be \$50 per player or \$200 per team.
- Auction on the team will proceed until the highest bid is secured by either the team or an outside owner.
- If the team is purchased by an outside owner, the team will be allowed to purchase half of the bid amount.
- All bids shall be made in cash, there will be no checks or credit cards allowed.
 - When an individual team member is not able to participate beyond the minimum \$50 per player, he shall first consult with his team about his limitation to participate to determine if one or more team members can make up the difference. If not, he shall consult with the Golf Committee via the Executive Manager to provide that full cash be placed at the time of the bid.
- The Committee wants to ensure that no player be discouraged from playing in the NECA Golf Tournament because of Calcutta requirements.
